

Ordinance No. 11-6-02

Ordinance to Establish Compensations & Job Descriptions for Village Employees

An Ordinance establishing Compensations and Job Descriptions for Village Employees.

Whereas, Section 3.1-10-40 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that every officer perform duties in addition to those prescribed by law, and be subject to other rules and regulations as the corporate authorities may provide by ordinance. 65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-40

Whereas, Section 3.1-50-20 of the Illinois Municipal Code further provides that the compensation of employees is determined by the corporate authorities. 65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-20

Whereas, the Village Board wishes to establish Code provisions relating to the compensations and job descriptions for Village Employees.

Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherrard, Mercer County, Illinois, that:

Pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, the revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Sherrard, Illinois, dated June, 2006, is hereby amended to add a new Title 10, Chapter 1 to read as follows:

Section 1: Compensation of Village Employees Attached and made a part of this Ordinance are the following "Agreement for Wages Paid" for each Village Employee:

Section 1.1 - Village Clerk

Section 1.2 – Police Chief

Section 1.3 - Police Officer (2 positions)

Section 1.4 – Water/Sewer Assistant Superintendent & Maintenance Supervisor

Section 1.5 – Water Billing Clerk

Section 1.6 – Maintenance

Section 1.7 – Building Inspector

Section 1.8 – Water/Sewer Superintendent

Section 2: Job Descriptions. Attached and made a part of this Ordinance are the following "Job Descriptions" for each Village Appointed Position:

Section 2.1 – Village Clerk

Section 2.2 – Police Chief

Section 2.3 – Police Officer

Section 2.4 - Water/Sewer Superintendent and Maintenance Positions

Section 2.5 – Water Billing Clerk

Section 2.6 – Building Inspector

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section 4: All prior Ordinances or provision contained in prior Ordinances or the Municipal Code of Sherrard of 2006 in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
